Main Viewpoint & Result:

According to the *Meson Theory* [1], in the case of not accepting any new particles, get the following conclusions: protons and neutrinos are the most elementary particles; a π -meson consists of combination of an electron and a neutrino; a neutron consists of a proton combination and a π -meson, the π -meson as a sub-shell and afterbirth, parcels, covered with the proton [2].
