

A hidden Quran Code: The tower of Babylon

Abstract

In the holy Quran Babylon is written one time (in verse 2:102). As explained in the following paper it contains the dimensions of the Tower of Babylon.

The verse 2:102 in Arabic (transliteration):

“wa ttaba’ū mā tatlū š-šayāṭīnu ‘alā mulki sulaymāna wa mā kafara sulaymānu
wa lākinna š-šayāṭīna kafarū yu’allimūna n-nāsa s-siḥra wa mā ‘unzila ‘alā
l-malakayni bi-bābila hārūta wa mārūta wa mā yu’allimāni min ‘aḥadin ḥattā
yaqūlā ‘innamā naḥnu fitnatun fa lā takfur fa yata’allamūna minhumā mā
yufarriqūna bihī bayna l-mar’i wa zawḡihī wa mā hum bi ḍarrīna bihī min ‘aḥadin
‘illā bi-’idni llāhi wa yata’allamūna mā yaḍurruhum wa lā yanfa’uhum wa la qad
‘alimū la-mani štarāhu mā lahū fi l-’āḥirati min ḥalāqin wa la bi’sa mā šaraw bihī
‘anfusahum law kānū ya’lamūna “

These are exactly 91 words.

The tower of Babylon has dimensions of 91x91x91 meters.

But there is something additional: The verse 2:102 is the 109th verse.

The 109th State Route of New York City (U.S.A.) ends in the part of the city called Babylon.

Everyone can check this miracle on Google Maps or another map service.

Conclusion

As we could see the number of words in the verse which contains the word “Babylon” is exactly 91 what are the dimensions of the tower of Babylon.

Additional we saw that the verse is the 109th verse of the holy Quran and that one important U.S. state route (the 109th) ends at a part of the city called Babylon.
